Information for Churches



YOUTH DAY

We will be running three different age groups

Group 1 - Reception, Yr1, Yr2. Group 2 - Yr3, Yr4, Yr5, Yr6. Group 3 - Secondary School.

We may run a 4th group for older secondary depending on numbers. These groups are approximate and flexible. It is open to ALL children and young people!

The day will include opportunities to join in worship, arts, crafts, sports, games and more.

The theme for the day is based around 1 John 13-24, which supports the young people in thinking about issues linked to friendship and love.

Lunch is provided for all attending, along with snacks.

There will be a tuck / merch stall open for young people to buy from if they wish. This will be provided by Hope Church East Cleveland. Suggested amount is a maximum of £5 or £10.

We are asking for a contribution of £3 per young person for the event. If you wish to pay as a group, or if the church is covering the costs. Please email us hope4eastcleveland@gmail.com we can provide you with a discount code, issue this to parents, ask them to book as normal and add the code at checkout. We will provide details of how churches can then transfer the cost of spaces. If costs are a barrier again get in touch and we can look at how we can support.

All young people are required to complete an online consent form before the event.

We are looking for adult volunteers for this event. Adults will be required to go through safer recruitment for volunteers, along with an enhanced DBS, we can arrange methodist DBS where required. If you need to bring younger children with you, please book them in, there is no charge but we need have consent form completed for all young people. Young people aged 14-17 can also volunteer to support with this event. They still require an online booking and consent, but there is no charge.

The day is perfect for both church young people, and other young people you may have contact with though youth groups, schools work or other outreach.

WHAT DO WE NEED?

Young people may like to bring

- A coat or jacket, older youth will have the opportunity to be off site
- some spending money for the tuck shop and gift stall, £5-10 is the most they would need, this is optional
- A bible, if not we we can loan one
- Any medication in a named plastic bag with details of dosage, to be signed in on arrival.
- Completed online consent form before the event.

TREASURE TRAIL (SECONDARY ONLY)

See God in the world around us, with a treasure trail based along the high street, ending with a treat! Chance to get out and about in small groups.

Express yourself with art! A variety of mediums and techniques that you can use to explore the themes of love and friendship.

COOKING

Do you love food? Time to get creative in the kitchen and cook up some sweet treats to enjoy

TABLE TOP GAMES

Relax with a variety of board games, mindfulness colouring and card game.



HOW TO BOOK

We are happy to come to visit your groups and churches to share information direct with others. Including information about the event, and to support with signing up for spaces.

Our booking is completed centrally, this is so that all information is stored securely. This also helps us in terms of safeguarding as the team have access to information that they need, and we can ensure parents have given permission for the event. It also supports churches as they don't need to be handling forms and money.

If churches wish to pay for spaces on behalf of young people, we can issue you a discount code. If this is entered at check out the space will be free. We can then arrange for payment direct for spaces from the church contact.
